From the Board - Exciting News for 2024

The Brandon League of Fine Arts is making great strides in membership and in spreading creative activity. Good things happening in 2024. Here are some of them.

1. Show Committee - Shows are BacK!

Now that Covid is past (mostly) The Strawberry Festival Art Show and The State Fair Art Show are back. And with our new home at Creative Junk Therapy, our shows will return; the Member show, the 4. Ways and Means. Please volunteer to manage the meeting raffle. Square Off and the Artworks show. Dates for all of these shows will be announced at the member meetings and in the newsletter. We need a Show/Reception Committee in charge of ordering ribbons, Judge, Call to Artists & publicity for the BLFA shows. They also organize the setting up, table cloths, drinks, etc.

- 2. Treasurer Dues. With so many new members and the success of the hands-on workshops, the annual member dues will have to increase. The dues have not changed for many, many years and since the League provides a Meetup site, snacks, and workshop supplies, our funds are rapidly depleting. So, the dues for the remainder of 2023 will continue to be \$35, but next year will increase to \$40. If you join or renew in Sept. through Dec. of 2023 you will not need to pay again in January.
- 3. Revolving Shows Change-Over. Roxanne has been diligent in coordinating the 3 Change-Over opportunities, but we're adding a new one. Chill Caw-Fee at the corner of Bloomingdale and Lithia

Pinecrest will allow us to exhibit and sell our art in their store. Working out the details, but will have a pilot show in October. Hopefully, it will resume in December.

Managing it means you just need to have a member/members sign up to donate a raffle item/basket and sell the tickets at the meeting. You can also tap a helper.

In an effort to increase our bank, the League is planning a garage sale in the Spring. So, don't get rid of good saleable items. Just put aside for the sale. Currently planning it at the Women's Club on Moon. Details to come.

- 5. Publicity. Now that we are growing and have a place to show, we need to tell the world. Who would like to be Publicity Chairman for the League? The Board will work with you.
- 6. Field Trips. Want to visit a museum as a group? We need a chairman to organize, pick a date, sign up members to car pool and contact the museum to arrange for a guided tour. I'm thinking of the James Museum across the Bay which is only \$10 on Tuesdays. Oh my goodness, so many different kinds of art. Inspiring for sure. I'll be glad to work with the Chairman on this.

Brandon League of Fines Art's Member Meeting Minutes - August 21, 2023

President Bonnie Phillips (BP) called the meeting to order at 18:46

Members in attendance: 15 members Visitors: 3 visitors (1 visitor from meetup)

Members sang 'happy birthday' to BP in advance of her actual birthday tomorrow.

BP mentioned the graphics provided from the June meeting could be worked on during the evening's demonstration of pastels by Alice Anderson.

Carol Stebbins is the new League Secretary.

BP asked for a volunteer to be Ways and Means Chairman, reminding the members "a good leader delegates," and it is a position that works with the members to accept assigned tasks, not performs every task. Among the tasks is to solicit refreshments for the meeting and donations for raffle gift bags. Raffle tickets are \$2 each or 3 for \$5. The 50/50 tickets are \$1 each or 6 for \$5.

BP asked for a motion to approve the July meeting minutes which was made by Beth Smedley (BS), League Membership Chairman. A second motion to accept was made by Christine Jacques. The minutes for July, 2023 meeting were approved.

The League Treasurer Nicki Romberger reported the current (as of 08/21/23) bank balance is \$5,777.80.

BP announced the raffle winners, Judy Gran and Chris Klein. The 50/50, \$14 was divided equally with \$7 going to the League.

Revolving Exhibit Chairman Roxanne Tobiason (RT) is coordinating a revolving exhibit to display members' works at three Bay Area Cardiology locations in Brandon, Riverview and TGH in staggered rotation back-to-back for 2 - 3 months. Patients and visitors

to these locations will have the opportunity to purchase the displayed artwork. BP suggested pricing should not be \$300 -\$500, instead follow previous sales pricing between \$70 - \$90. Historically, a sale price of \$100 is rare. She also recommended to include sales tax in the price of the piece. The doctors office will collect the money for sales. RT requested to keep her informed of the pieces being submitted for display. A requirement to include hanging wire with the art as some pieces will be displayed in patient areas, we don't want something to fall on someone. Another reminder is during the placement of art, keep socializing and noise to a minimum so the physicians and staff, patients will not be disturbed. RT asks the members to advise her this evening of submissions for Friday, August 25, between 13:30 - 14:30.

BP announced the September general meeting will include a demonstration of oil portraiture by Chris Klein. Tickets for \$2 each will be sold, the winner will have their portrait done by Chris. The October general meeting will include a demonstration by BS of Gelli Plate printing. November's meeting demonstration has not been confirmed, possible macrame' demonstration TBA.

BP announced next year the League will be having shows again. This was met with enthusiasm by several members.

BP asked if there were any questions or comments.

BP announced a new visitor. Jennifer brought an example of her work, acrylic painting on wood slice, which was admired by everyone. She advised she enjoys painting on wood, and treats the wood with gesso before painting.

BP encouraged the members to bring in their 'show and tell' art to our meetings.

Meeting was adjourned 19:00.
