“Paint It & Take It”



The annual Artworks show has returned. The details and application are attached in the newsletter. However, just as a reminder how to properly frame your work for hanging. Very important.

Proper Framing

It's important for safety and professionalism to properly frame your artwork.

No sawtooth hangers

Screw eyes must be secured well so not as to pull out. We suggest the hooks seen in the picture below for better support.

Remember, the way you present your work is a reflection of your professionalism. It is always nice to finish off the back of your work to make it pleasing (not required). If your work is purchased, you don't want the customer to return it with broken wire, glass or problems.

Matting: Make sure it is clean, no stains. If you are using glass, make sure the glass is secured. **Be sure your points are behind the mat - NOT in front.** Check your work carefully before bringing it in. We will not accept poorly framed pieces for legal reasons.

Drop off – Tuesday, November 30

Artist Reception – Thursday, December 9, 5 - 7 p.m.

Pick up – Friday, December 17

Each artist can submit 3 pieces, but may do more or less depending on the size.

Your piece should have a wire hanger that can hang from

a picture hanger on a wall. For sculpture and non-hanging pieces, details to come. Each piece should be labeled with the name of the piece, basic type of material, and price if you want to sell it.

Friends, family and fans are invited to the artist reception. Snacks and wine will most likely be available. This is a first for CJT. A gathering to view everyone's work and celebrate their achievements with fellow artists and supporters. It is a great opportunity to display the uniqueness of the Creative Junk Therapy artists and give exposure to the upcycle and reuse cause.

ARTWORKS 2021

Mook Gallery at Center Place
August 27 - September 27



This annual, juried exhibition is organized by the Brandon League of Fine Arts and hosted by Center Place Fine Arts and Civic Association. All artists are invited to submit their new work.

Artists Reception

Thursday, September 9, Mook Gallery, Center Place, 5:30 - 7 p.m.

Rules:

All work must be original; the artist's own creative concept, composition and design. Not copies of other artist's work or completed with instructor assistance. No nudes or religious subjects, reproductions or photos on canvas including giclees.

2D work may not exceed 40" in any dimension including frame. Large works on paper should be under plexi or glass. Frame must be wired for hanging. Gallery wrap canvas must have screw eyes between the stretchers and hang flat on the wall. **No sawtooth hangers! Without proper framing and wiring or with other deviation from these rules, work will not be accepted for exhibition.**

3D work including fiber, ceramics, metal, jewelry, glass and wood may not be taller than 18", wider than 12" and weight not to exceed 3 lbs.

All work must have been completed after September 2018 and not previously submitted to a BLFA or Center Place competition.

Entry fee:

BLFA Members: 1 entry - \$25, 2 entries - \$35

Non-Members: 1 entry - \$35, 2 entries - \$45

*BLFA membership is available for \$35/year

Awards:

First place: \$500 awarded by Center Place

Second place: \$300

Thirds place: \$150

2 Honorable mention: \$50 each

Center Place retains a 30% donation on any sales during this exhibit.

Drop off:

Center Place, 619 Vonderburg Drive, Brandon, FL on Friday, August 27, 9:30 a.m. - Noon

Judging will be at Noon and artists will be notified after 2 p.m.

If your work was not accepted for inclusion in the show, it must be picked up by 5 p.m. that day.

The exhibition will close **Monday, Sept. 27, 2021**. All work **MUST** be picked up **that morning** between 10-12:30 p.m. Work that is not picked up by this time will become property of BLFA.

Liability Statement: All reasonable care will be taken to insure protections of submitted work. No liability can be assumed by the sponsors or any personnel connected to the exhibit for damage to or loss of submitted work.
