

#### Brandon League of Fines Art's Member Meeting Minutes - September 18, 2023

The meeting was called to order at 6:34 pm by President, Bonnie Phillips (BP), who began by welcoming the members to the new meeting facility at Creative Junk Therapy.

BP mentioned the 50/50 and this evening's portrait raffle. The portrait raffle winner will be the portrait subject of Chris Klein's oil painting demonstration.

BP encouraged the members to bring their show-and-tell projects to share with the members.

BP asked for a motion to approve last month's meeting minutes. Guy Learn motioned to approve, Chris Klein seconded. Motion carried.

Nicki Romberger (NR), League Treasurer reported the current bank balance, as of 09/18/23, was \$5,135.96. NR advising League annual dues will increase for membership in 2024, from \$35 for an individual/\$40 for family, to \$40 for individual/\$50 for family. BP encouraged members to pay their annual dues prior to yearend 2023, at the 2023 rate. Dues paid after January 2024 will be \$40 plus \$5 late fee.

Committee Chairman Beth Smedley (BS) began her report by saying how happy she was to see the evening's attendance at 20 members, 5 visitors. BS handed out membership name buttons, asked to be notified if a member did not receive the newsletter. BS reviewed the current BLFA newsletter mention of the Strawberry Festival's new space, which EHAG (East Hillsborough Art Guild) sponsors. The bigger space will allow for expanded exhibits during February, 2024 Strawberry Festival. For more information visit EHAGfinearts.org.

BS provided description of next month's workshop, Gelli Plate printing. She recommended viewing YouTube videos to gain an introduction to the process. Bring a brayer and

Gelli plate to next month's demonstration.

BP mentioned October's Halloween theme for the next meeting, wear a costume or hat in competition for a prize.

Roxanne Tobiason (RT), Revolving Exhibit Chairman, referenced information also provided in the current newsletter for members to submit their work for display and sale at Bay Area Cardiology locations. Read instructions published in the newsletter, and preregister in order to participate by Wednesday, September 27. RT cautions art work must not be too heavy and appropriately wired to avoid falling, as patients will be in the display areas. She asks to be kept apprised of all art work sales, any pieces being removed or added so an exact inventory is maintained. Any funds received for sold art will be collected by that doctors' office and disbursed to the artist.

BP called for Old Business, and a motion to approve Guy Learn as First Vice President, BS motioned for approval; Motion carried.

BP called for a motion to approve Carol Stebbins as Secretary; Motion carried.

There was no New Business to discuss.

SHOW-AND-TELL

BP offered congratulations to BLFA member Dineen Roeller for winning First Place at the Carrollwood Cultural Center's EMERGing Artist exhibit. Dineen brought the winning piece along with other examples of her work.

Guy Learn brought his Christmas card painting, and related that the ornaments on his family tree always seemed out of focus until he got glasses.

Karen Koseck displayed her watercolor seascape and mentioned a technique she learned from fellow BFLA member to use complementary colors of dark green palm trees against an orange sky background.

Dineen Roeller displayed her wire sculpture figures and discussed the process to create an armature. She also displayed a painting of a woman which used tissue paper and over-painting using mixed media (watercolor, acrylic, ink, and Modge Podge) to create a special effect.

These artists' works were examined and admired by everyone in attendance.

BP announced November's workshop will be watercolor pencils with Dineen.

The December general meeting and Christmas party will be held on Monday, December 11, at CJT.

BP announced the BFLA Board Meeting will be held Monday, September 25, 6:00 PM, at CJT.

Reminder that any member can attend, along with the Board of Directors. BP asked for volunteers for the following Chair positions:

Ways and Means – recruit member volunteers to donate items for raffle, sell tickets at meeting.

Show/Reception – order prize ribbons, Judge, Call to Artists, publicity for BLFA shows.

Publicity – write articles of interest about BFLA activities for newspaper publication, submit by

10th of the month.

Field Trips – organize members to convene at a location.

Paint Out - paint/photography/creative activity at a location.

Raffle winners: Lynn Paul won the oil portrait and Carlene Earl won the 50/50.

Meeting adjourned at 6:59 PM.
