Want to Try Pastels?

Michele Young will be hosting a demo/workshop to show you how.



This month we'll be exploring soft pastels with Michele Young. Michele is an excellent colored pencil and pastel artist. At this meeting she'll explain the different types of pastels and the surfaces that work best for pastels. She'll demonstrate what combination of materials work well together, depending on the desired look or subject matter, including how to mix pastels with other art mediums. Participants will be able to follow along with

the demonstration by trying out the materials. All supplies will be provided. We will create an easy pastel landscape painting.










*If you are not a member and have attended a workshop, the fee for additional workshops is \$20. If you join for \$40, workshops are free and you are paid for a year.

Member Exhibit & Prize Drawing



Brandon League of Fine Arts Members' Show 2024

PLEASE REVIEW the NEW rules: sizes and weight, different venue with different rules.

This is not an exhibit, it is a show with awards. It is the first big show for the League since Covid.

Take-in day: THURSDAY, May 16, 2024. 10 a.m. to Noon.

RULES:

1. Members in good standing may submit TWO pieces of art, not to exceed 30 inches in either dimension and not to exceed 25 lbs.

3D works must be hung on display racks. Also, cannot weigh over 25 lbs.

- 2. All works meeting the required criteria will be accepted.
 All work to be hung. ONLY works with proper hanging* wires (see images below) will be accepted. Sawtooth or screw eyes hardware will be rejected. Do not include tags, stickers or ribbons from previous shows.
- 3. All work must have been completed within the last 5 years and has not been shown in a BLFA show.
- 4. All work must be **ORIGINAL** and created solely by the artist. No copies of the works of other artists, no copies of instruction book lessons, and no teacher demonstrated works or teacher-assisted works will be accepted.
- 5. Laser reproduction, commercial prints or works from commercial molds are **not eligible**.
- 6. All works must remain on exhibit throughout the entire length of the exhibit.
- 7. Awards will be determined at the discretion of the exhibit committee.
- 8. A qualified professional will judge the show.
- 9. Because children visit the gallery, works containing nudity or horror are not accepted.
- 10. There is no category distinction.
- 11. Any sales will be handled directly with the artist and no commissions are due.

ENTRY FEE: \$15 or 2 for \$25 cash or check. This is not a juried show so all member work presented will be accepted. Fee may be mailed to: Brandon League of Fine Arts, 776 W. Lumsden Road, Brandon, FL 33511

AWARDS: 1st. place 50% of take-in. 2nd place 30% of take-in. 3rd place 15% of take-in. HM 2 ribbons at \$25 each.

Take-in day: THURSDAY, May 16, 2024. 10 a.m. to Noon. (See a BLFA board member if you cannot deliver yourself)

Pick-up day: MONDAY, June 17, after Member's monthly June meeting.

LOCATION: Creative Junk Therapy, 776 Lumsden Rd., Brandon

LIABILITY: At the time of delivery of artwork to Creative Junk Therapy and the Members' Show committee the artist must sign the entry slip, which acts as a declaration discharging the BLFA, its committee members and all other participating and sponsoring organization from any and all manner of actions, suits, damages or claims whatsoever arising from any loss or damage to the property of the artist while in the possession or supervision of the BLFA Members' Show committee. The artist agrees to abide by the Members' Show rules and understands the Committee reserves the right to make the final interpretation of the rules.

BLFA GENERAL MEETING NOTES March 18, 2024

From Secretary, Carol Stebbins

Beth Smedley (BS) opened the meeting at 6:37 PM, welcomed members and guests to the meeting. She asked Membership Chairperson Guy Learn to introduce visitors and provide attendance for the meeting and new members.

BS asked for award winners at the Strawberry Festival to identify themselves and offered congratulations.

BS announced two speakers for the evening, Kathy Carrier who will display her papier mâché sculpture and discuss her process, and Michele Stone from Florida Craft Art in St. Petersburg, who will provide details of the organization and description of the categories of three-dimensional art work accepted for exhibit.

BS then mentioned the successful garage sale fundraiser 03/09, announced the event made \$380 + dollars for the League, thanked all donors and those who assisted with the sale. She suggested another garage sale in the Fall, TBA.

BS mentioned the BLFA March Craft event and mentioned Carol Stebbins' conducted the workshop in the CJT Makers Space March 16. Kits of the three craft projects can be purchased for \$5 each.

BS announced the Member Art Sampler workshop upcoming March 30, 10:30 – 1:00 PM, hosted by CJT in the Collaborative Meeting space. All materials provided; cost is \$40 per participant. Artists will demonstrate watercolor, pastels, and mono printing techniques.

BS announced the winner of the BLFA For the Love of Art exhibit, whose name was drawn from names of those members who entered the exhibit. Dineen Roeller (DR) was the winner of a gift certificate and a handmade trophy made by BS. DR received applause from the group for the award. BS asked that those members who contributed the art work remove it after the meeting.

BS announced the Member Show upcoming in May, which will include awards and cash prizes judged independently. BLFA members will be charged a small fee to enter their art work.
